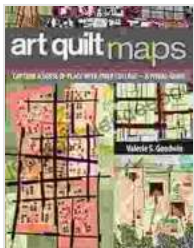

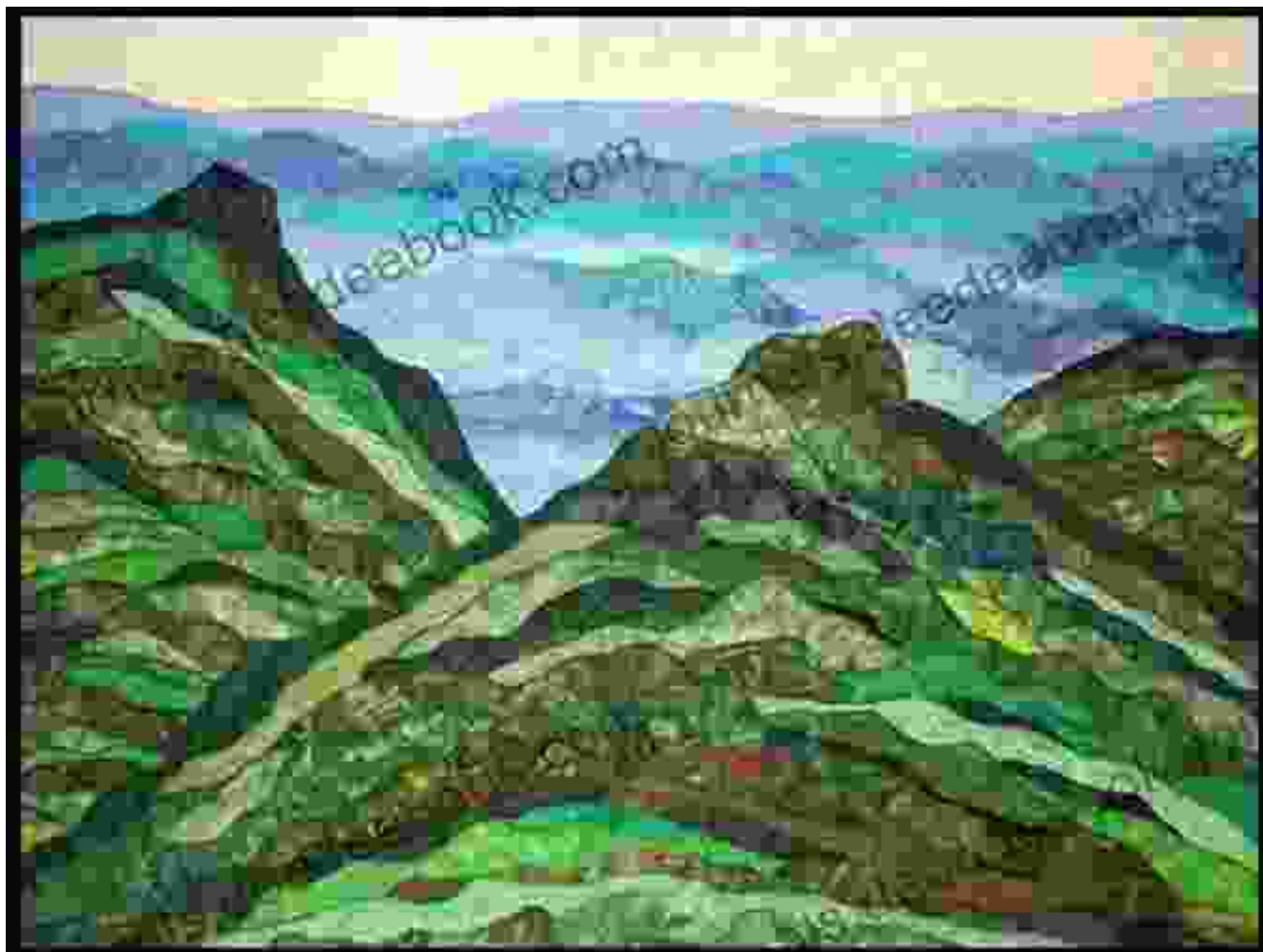

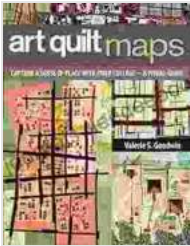
This fiber collage depicts the vibrant energy of a city street, incorporating found objects such as buttons and ribbons.

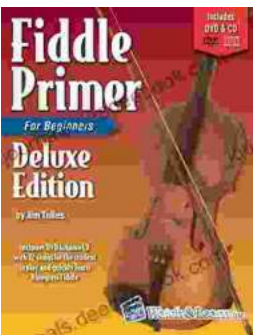

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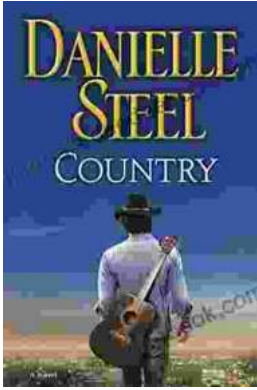
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
