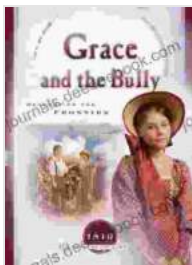

Day after day, Grace endured Emily's relentless taunts and cruel pranks. Her once-bright smile faded into a dull glimmer, and her spirit began to wilt

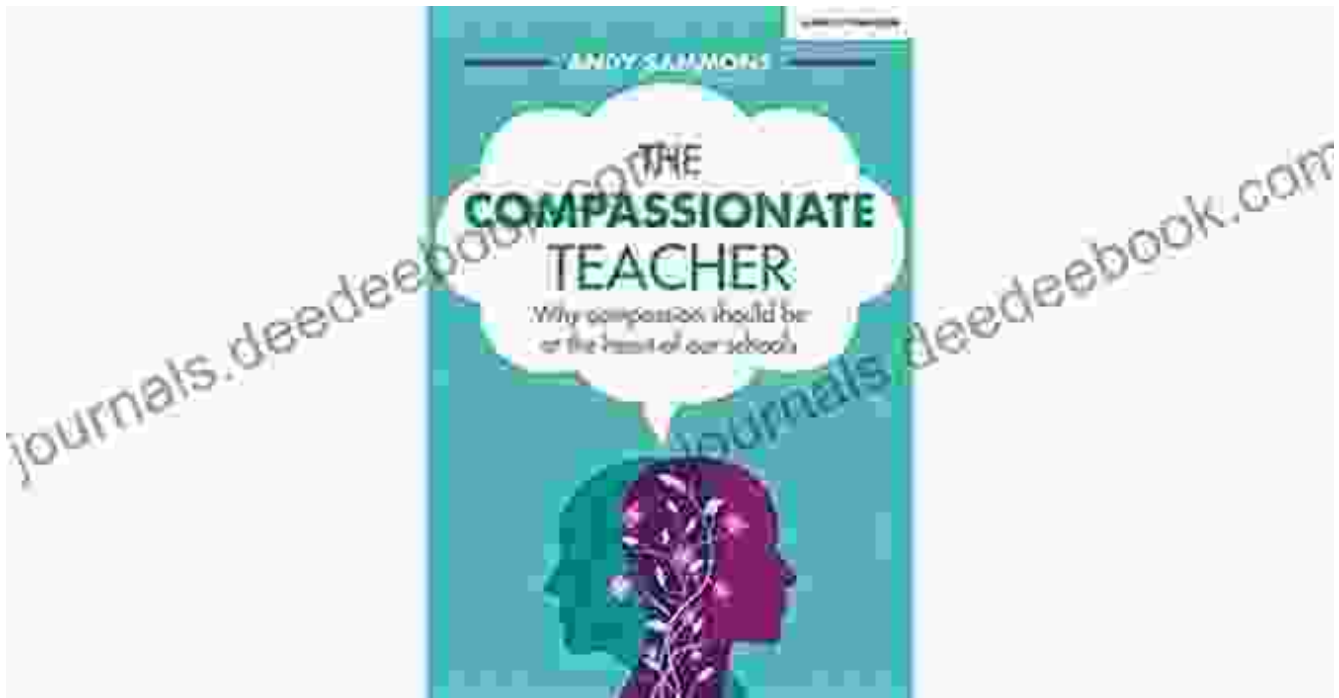

The bully's reign of terror was over. Emily, once feared and despised, became an outcast, her cruelty exposed to the light of truth.

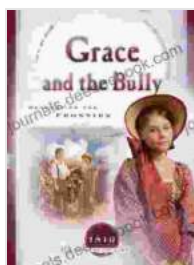


Grace surrounded by her friends after standing up to Emily

in the face of adversity, the human spirit has an indomitable ability to triumph.



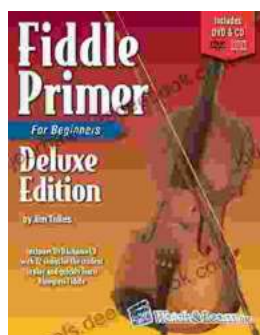

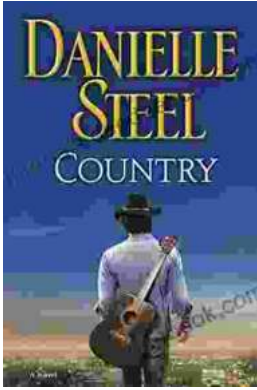
